	Question	Response
1.	We are a company from NY, are we allowed to bid on this project	Yes
2.	Is this a project Women/Minority Business Enterprise (WMBE)? And / Or Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB)?	Certified WMBE vendors are able to self-perform on this project. This is not a set-aside.
3.	Walk Thru mandatory?	No, Walk Thru at this time. A walk thru may be required at the project level.
4.	What is the Total sq ft and Material required for installation?	Total sq ft and materials will be developed at the project level.
5.	What is on the floor currently?	Some area has carpet only, some areas asbestos floor tile and mastic, some areas both carpet and asbestos floor tile. When a project is identified, the awarded vendors will have an opportunity to assess the current floor.
6.	Can we request drawings/floor plans now	Drawings and floor plans will be available at the project level.
7.	What are the specs on the replacement material?	Floor tile will be Armstrong Cottage Tan VCT.
8.	Has there been testing for asbestos	Yes, areas have been tested for asbestos.
