



DUVAL HIGH SCHOOL

ATHLETIC STADIUM RENOVATION

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Prince George's County Public Schools is advancing a comprehensive, phased renovation of the existing DuVal High School stadium and athletic facilities. The project will replace the existing natural-grass stadium field with a new synthetic turf field, rebuild the regulation-size track and field event areas, and provide new bleachers, a press box, scoreboards, sports and egress lighting, fencing, and accessible pathways throughout the stadium.

Additional improvements include a new ticket booth and storage building; upgraded baseball and softball backstops and batting tunnels; improved field drainage and stormwater management; and new electrical infrastructure to support the stadium's lighting, scoreboards, press box, and field operations.

The completed project will provide safer and more reliable playing conditions, improved accessibility, updated spectator amenities, and modern facilities supporting football, soccer, flag football, lacrosse, track and field, baseball, and softball.

PROJECT FUNDING SECURED

Approximately \$12.4 million has been secured to complete the DuVal High School stadium renovation, including funding for comprehensive stadium improvements and new bleachers.

Funding Sources

- \$6.7 million in PGCPS capital funding
- \$4.5 million in state grant funding, including \$500,000 secured by Senator Alonzo Washington
- \$1.2 million through the Aging Schools Program

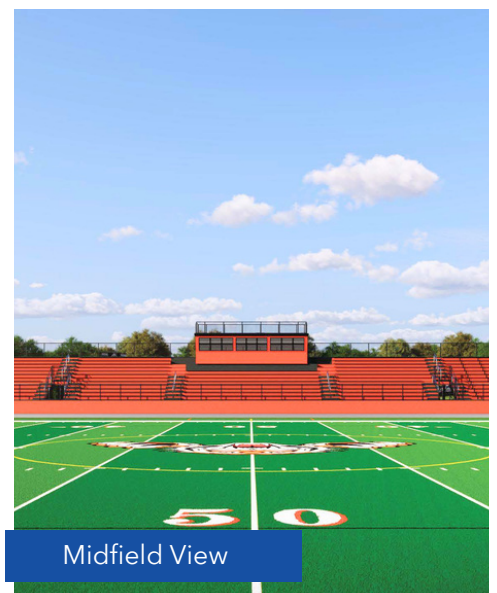

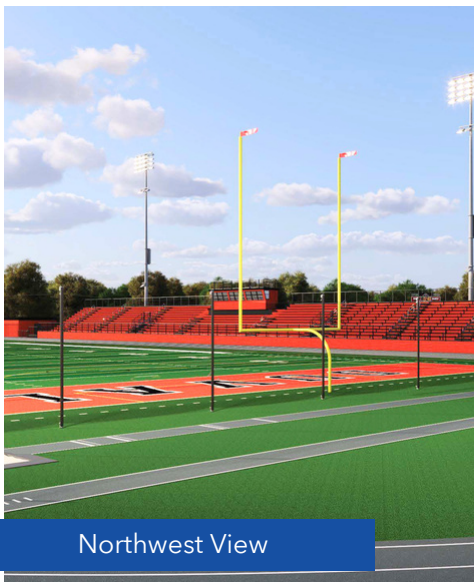


Midfield View

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Summer - Fall 2026	Design, permitting, and bleacher fabrication.
Fall 2026	Maintain the existing stadium for fall sports; anticipated bleacher delivery and staging.
Winter 2026 - Summer 2027	Site mobilization and construction.
Fall 2027	Anticipated completion and reopening for fall sports.



PROJECT FEATURES

- Turf Field:** A new multipurpose synthetic turf stadium field designed to support football, soccer, flag football, and lacrosse, with an upgraded drainage system for more consistent playing conditions.
- Track and Field Facilities:** A rebuilt regulation-size track and updated track-and-field event areas, including facilities for high jump, long and triple jump, pole vault, shot put, and discus.
- Bleachers and Press Box:** New spectator bleachers and an updated press box with the structural, electrical, and accessibility improvements needed to support athletic events.
- Lighting and Scoreboards:** New Musco stadium lighting with theatrical lighting capabilities, additional egress lighting, and new stadium and baseball scoreboards.
- Accessibility and Site Circulation:** New accessible walkways and ramps, concrete steps with handrails, and improved circulation throughout the stadium.
- Baseball and Softball Improvements:** New batting tunnels and replacement backstops and fencing to enhance practice and competition facilities for both programs.
- Fencing and Site Security:** New perimeter fencing, gates, and field enclosures to improve stadium access, operations, and security.
- Supporting Facilities and Infrastructure:** A new ticket booth, storage building, flagpoles, electrical outlets, utility connections, and supporting stormwater management improvements.
