1. Complete the attached Career and Technical Education (CTE) Youth Apprenticeship Program Student Application Form

2. Submit your resume which includes the following:

- Your Contact Information (name, address, email, phone number)
- A 3-5 sentence statement on why we should consider you to be a participant in the CTE Youth Apprenticeship Program;
- Education (including your current school, current grade level, and Construction Trade courses/training);
- Personal Strengths (encouraging others; working as part of a team; being accurate or precise; visualizing colors, shapes, and concepts; fixing, repairing, building and using tools; keeping deadlines, etc.)
- High School Awards and Honors;
- Volunteer and Community Service;
- Extra-curricular Activities;
- Employment Information (including unpaid internships); and
- Additional Skills, Hobbies.

3. Submit your current transcript (must include1st Quarter of 11th Grade)

4. Have your teacher complete the Teacher Evaluation Form
