1. Online

2. In-Person at Your School on Aug. 10 or 11

School Bus Transportation Reminders



To secure school bus transportation for the start of the 2022-23 school year, your student *must* be registered for school by Wednesday, Aug. 10.

Elementary school students residing one and one-half miles or more from their assigned school, and middle school and high school students residing two miles or more from their assigned school are eligible for transportation.
