MCAP: Elementary School Math Shines



PGCPS students showed modest gains on the 2023-24 Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP), with nearly a third of schools improving by two percentage points or more in English Language Arts (ELA) and/or mathematics, including 35 schools with at least a five percentage point improvement. In math, students saw improvements in grades 3, 4, 5 as well as Algebra I!

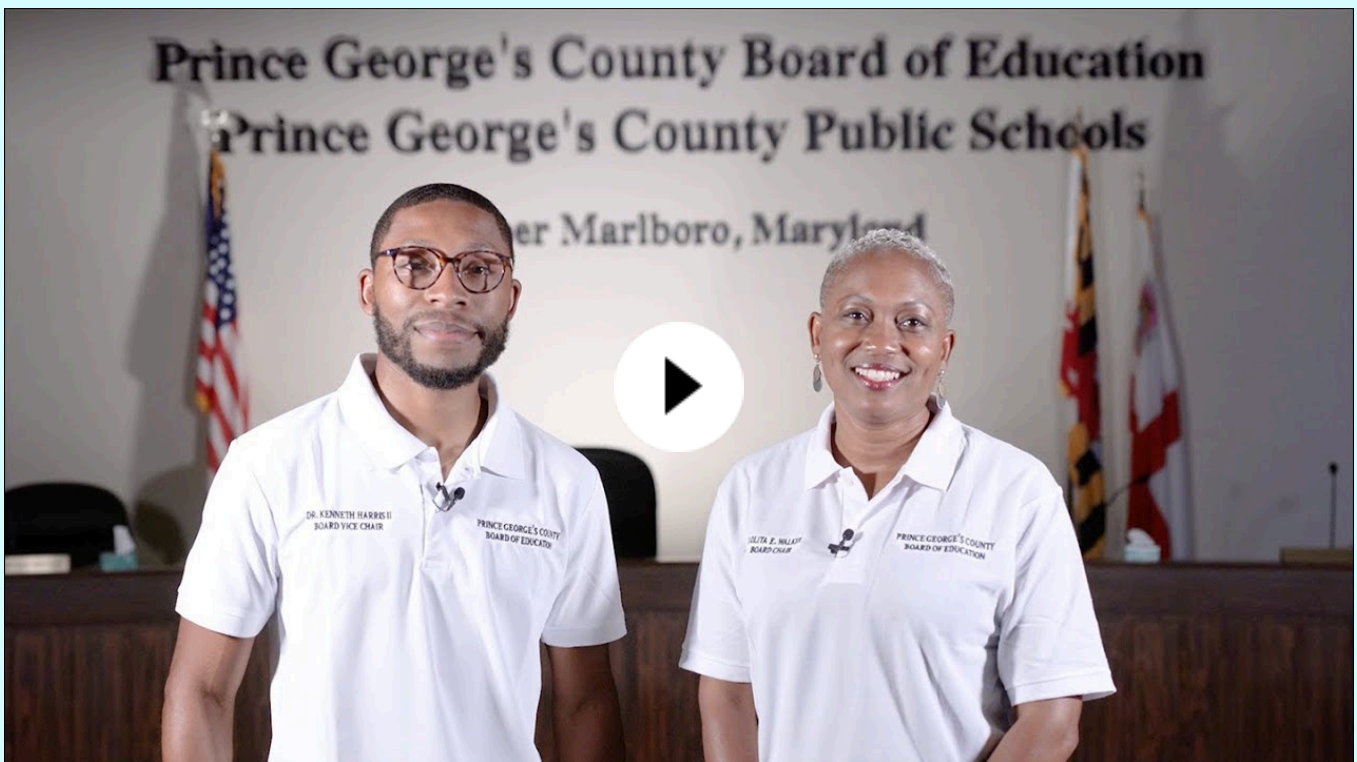
