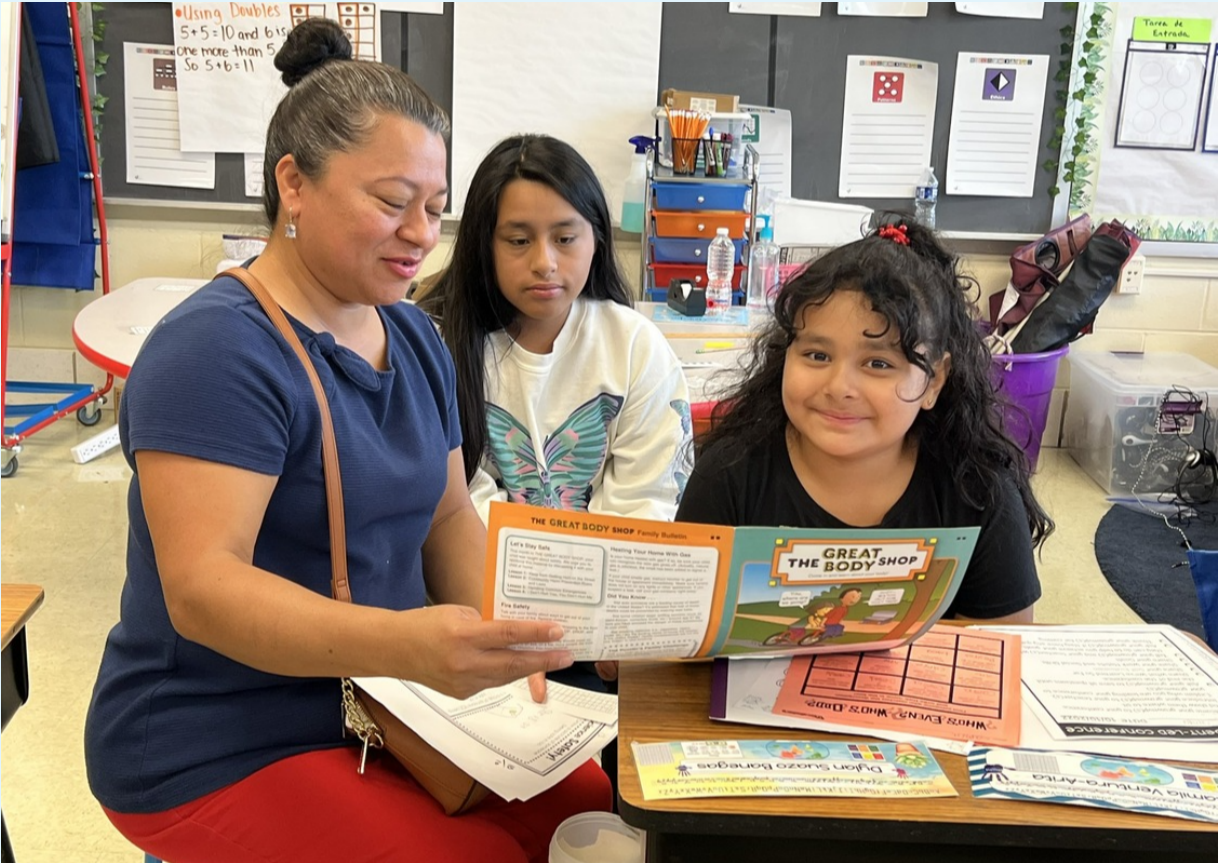
Free Reading Tutoring for K–5 Students

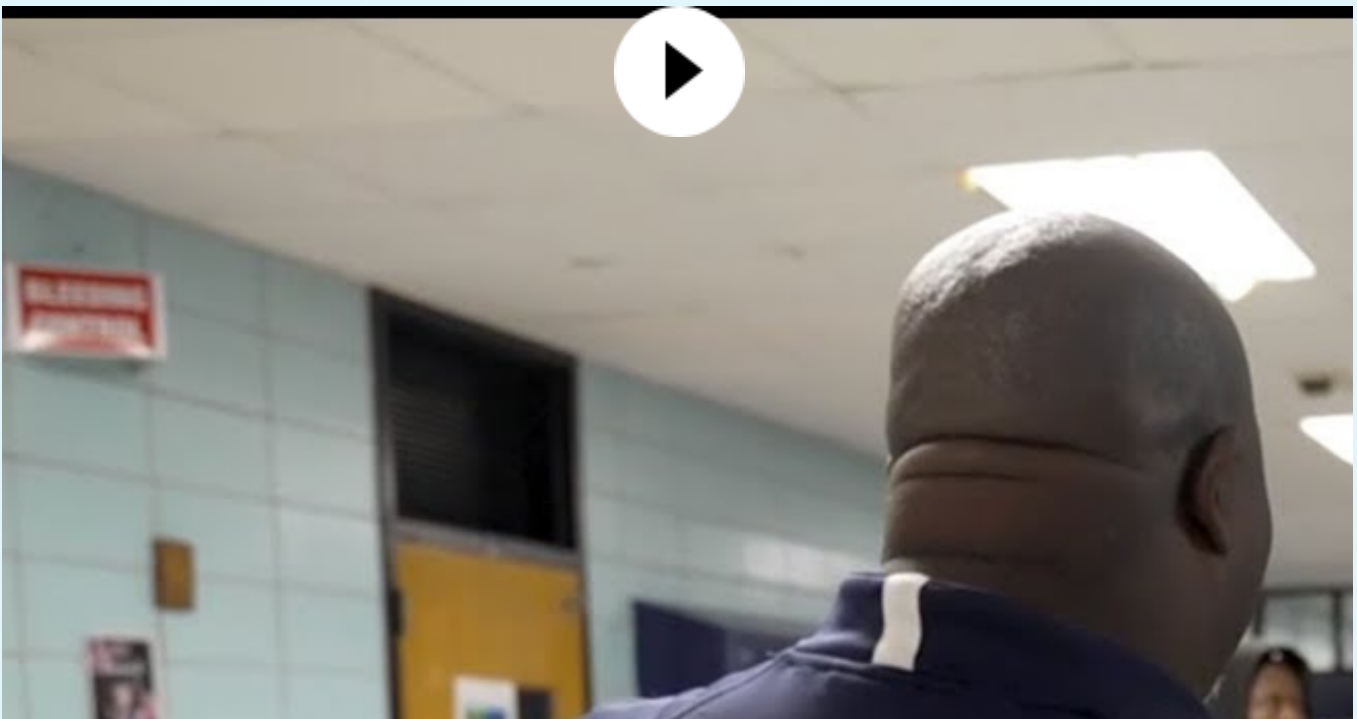
