Did you know meals are free for all students through year end? You have two options for getting them on **Mondays and Wednesdays between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.**

Pickup from a school — Simply visit your neighborhood school or a school close to home.

Meal Delivery — Look for the school bus at one of these community meal delivery sites.

Children picking up meals do not need identification. We ask that parents/ guardians bring a student ID or other verification of enrollment to support the number of meals requested.
